REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Please fill out the Application form & **return to the Preschool office by January 31**. You can mail or drop-off the application form to the Preschool office. Please be sure to address the form to my attention, *Sandra Foltz-Preschool Department*. On February 1st you will be notified by email or phone of any open positions. - Our required **Registration/Activity fee** of \$235.00 per child or \$360.00 per family will be due May 1st -May 30th (please do not pay this fee before May 1st).

2-YEAR MOTHER'S MORNING OUT

- For children who will be 2 by September 1st, 2018. A child who turns 2 in September or October can participate if there are openings after registration in a **2 day** position
- **Hours:** August 9:30- 12:00; September-May 9:30-1:00
- **Class Options:** Tuesday-Friday, with 4 day, 3 day and 2 day options
- **Tuition:** **2-day:** \$240; **3-day:** \$275; **4-day:** \$300
- **Class ratio:** 12 children with two teachers
- **Description:** MMO is primarily a playgroup, where children make new friends and also learn to follow instruction from their teachers in a classroom setting. There is a curriculum that the teachers use for art projects, story time themes and circle time. Prayer starts our day and is incorporated throughout the preschool schedule. The children will bring in their own snack and lunch. Outdoor play is also in the schedule each day. Religion is taught in the chapel weekly beginning in October.

3-YEAR PRESCHOOL

- For children who will be three by September 1st, 2018
- **Hours:** 9:30-1:00
- **Class Options:** **3-day Tues/Thurs/Fri** class (2 day-T/TH is an option), **or** **5-day** (4 day option M, T, W, TH- Friday off)
- **Tuition:** **3 day:** \$275 (**2-day**=\$240); **5 day**=\$315 (**4 day**= \$300)
- **Class Ratio:** 14-16 children with two teachers
- **Description:** This program uses a traditional approach. Students will visit learning centers so the teachers can work with the children on an individual basis for the academic and small motor skills. Prayer starts our day and is incorporated throughout the preschool schedule. The students will bring in their own lunch. Outside time is daily and Religion is once a week. Students entering the 3 year classes need to be "potty-trained" and they must be ready to use our bathroom facilities independently, having an understanding of what needs to be done. We work with students who may not be completely trained, however, pull-ups will be required in this case and parents will be called to assist in the changes if the episodes are frequent.

PRE-KINDERGARTEN PRESCHOOL

- For children who will be 4 by September 1st, 2018
- **Hours:** 9:30-1:00
- **Class Options:** **5 day** (4 day option has Friday off)
- **Tuition:** **5 day**-\$325; **4 day**- \$305 (Pre-K has a \$25.00 workbook fee due in September)
- **Class Ratio:** 16-20 students/ 1 teacher & assistant
- **Description:** This program uses a traditional approach. Students will visit learning centers so the teachers can work with the children on an individual basis. Prayer starts our day and is incorporated throughout the preschool schedule. The children will bring in their own lunch. The Pre-K class will have an outside time.
 - Religion is once a week and the Religion teacher will take the students to the church.
 - A Music teacher will visit once a month.
 - A Science teacher will visit once a week.
 - An Enrichment teacher will be here once a week for those students who scored higher on the "Getting Ready To Read" screening test at the beginning of the school year.

- Our goal for the Pre-K class is to prepare each child for Kindergarten. Our Pre-K uses the same objectives established by Bright from the Start and the State of Georgia –“GELDS”. Our certified teacher will accomplish these objectives by using various curriculum materials:
 - “Handwriting Without Tears” workbook series
 - “Happily Ever After” Pre-Reading Series by Rowland Reading Foundation
 - Scholastic Weekly Readers-“Let's Find Out”
 - Creative Writing Activities
 - Worksheet activities
 - Folder Game activities
