

A.) That-Than-Which-None-Greater-Can-Be-Conceived ["TNGC"] does not exist in reality.

1.) TNGC exists in the mind.

- Criticism: God does not exist in the mind

2.) All else equal, it is greater to exist in reality and in the mind, than in mind alone.

- Criticism: Greater is subjective

3.) Something can be conceived with all of TNGC's qualities, plus existence in reality.

- Criticism: Existence is not a predicate

QED: For TNGC, something greater can be conceived

- Criticism: Thinking does not mean it is true
- Criticism: Gaunilo's Greatest Island
